BOOKINGS

LOCATION

Lady Gowrie Tasmania's Lansdowne Vacation Care is located at Lansdowne Crescent Primary School in Gourlay Street, West Hobart. The program operates from the school's General Purpose room. The best entrance to use is from Gourlay Street - enter through the lower gate and head up the hill until you see some double glass doors.

OPENING HOURS AND AGE RANGE

The program is open from 7.30am to 6.00pm. We cater for children from 4 to 12 years of age. 4 year old children must be enrolled in Kindergarten in 2024 to use this program.

FEES AND CHARGING PRACTICES

For daily fee please refer to the current Fee Schedule displayed at the service. The Child Care Subsidy is available for all eligible families by contacting the Department of Human Services on 136.150. Families will be emailed an invoice from Lady Gowrie Tasmania each fortnight. Payments can only be made by using the Debit Success system which automatically deducts all monies owing on a set Friday on a fortnightly basis from your nominated bank account or credit card. Debit Success charges a \$19.95 overdue fee for all overdue accounts. The daily session fee may vary as indicated on the program and will still be charged if your child is absent from the program. A late collection fee of \$20 per 10 minutes or part thereof will be charged for children who are not collected by close of the service.

CANCELLATIONS AND BOOKINGS

Bookings made online are immediately confirmed but may be cancelled by the service manager at their discretion if the day is oversubscribed or your account is in arrears. In this case you will be advised as soon as practical. If your child is absent on their booked day, please inform the OSHC Managers by phoning 6230 6806 or by using the My Family Lounge app. An absence will be charged unless 7 days notice is provided as described in the Contract of Care. Under national law, if your child is absent on the first or last day of a booking Child Care Subsidy cannot be provided and therefore full fees will apply.

SIGNING CHILDREN IN AND OUT

Children must be signed in and out each day by a parent/ guardian or authorised person over the age of 18. If your child/ ren are absent you will be asked to sign for that day to acknowledge they were absent. This is a legal requirement and stipulation for you to receive your Child Care Subsidy entitlements.

WHAT TO BRING

We provide nutritious snacks for morning tea and afternoon tea and the daily menu is on display at the service. Families will need to provide a healthy lunch and drink bottle (water only) for their children. Please do not send any food which requires reheating or refrigeration. We are an allergy aware service so please ensure your child/ren do not bring any foods containing nuts. Please cater for all weather possibilities and provide sensible footwear and clothing. Lady Gowrie Tasmania's Sun Safe Policy applies from September to April each year so during these months please provide sun safe clothing including a broad brimmed or legionnaire style hat for your child/ren. Please note that we do not accept any responsibility for personal belongings children might bring to the service, including electronic devices. We limit the use of electronic items to one hour per day and children must not have internet access on these devices. Excursion costs are covered by the excursion fees (listed in the attached program) so we ask that children do not bring any additional money to the service on excursion days.

I understand that a risk assessment has been conducted and written policies and procedures for transporting children are available at the Service upon request. Following Lansdowne Crescent until the roundabout where we will be taking the 3rd exit onto Hill Street. Continuing onto Melville Street before turning right onto Molle Street followed by a left turn onto Bathurst Street. We will then be turning right onto Barrack Street and turning right onto Davey Street. Then we will turn left onto Southern Outlet, following the Southern Outlet for 10km, at the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Huon Highway. We will then be exiting the Huon Highway onto Summerleas Road where we will merge onto Summerleas Road before turning right onto Kingston View Drive, continuing until the entrance of the sports center. On returning to the service, we will be hopping back onto the bus heading south-west towards Kingston View Drive and turning right onto Kingston View Drive. Turn left onto Summerleas Road, staying on Summerleas Road until the off ramp onto Huon Highway where we will merge onto Huon Highway then we will continue left merging onto the Southern Outlet. Following the Southern Outlet until we turn right onto Macquarie Street. Following Macquarie Street until we turn left onto Molle Street, and then another left turn onto Melville Street, continue onto Hill Street and at the roundabout and exit onto Lansdowne Crescent.	Bus
